## Timetable of Crucifixion Events

Time	Reference	Event	Note
Friday 3 <sup>rd</sup> Apr 33 A.D. (traditionally 7/4/30) 6:00 a.m.	Jn 19:14-16	... about the sixth hour. "Here is your king" Pilate said to the Jews." But they shouted "Take him away! ... Crucify him!". Finally Pilate handed him over to them to be crucified.	Day of Preparation is the day before the Sabbath i.e Friday. John uses the Roman clock here. Other refs use Hebrew clock.
9:00 a.m.	Mk 15:25	It was the third hour when they crucified him.	The Hebrew clock begins at 6 am.
12:00 noon	Mk 15:33 Mt 27:45ff Lk 23:44ff	At the sixth hour darkness came over the whole land until the ninth hour.	Luke adds that this was because the sun stopped shining. The cause of this - natural or spiritual - is not given.
3:00 p.m.	Mk 15:34ff Mt 27:46ff Lk 23:44ff Jn 19:28ff	With a loud cry, Jesus breathed his last ... and gave up his spirit.	A sponge of wine vinegar is offered to Jesus before he dies. As he does so, the temple curtain is torn in two.
Sunday 5 <sup>th</sup> April 33 A.D. (traditionally 9/4/30)	Mk 16:1ff Mt 28:1ff Lk 24:1 ff	Mary Magdalene, Mary the mother of James, and Salome visit the tomb and find it empty.	It is very early in the morning, at dawn, just after sunrise.
Third Day	Mt 16:21 Lk 9:22 Acts 10:40 and others	The Resurrection	From Friday morning (1 <sup>st</sup> Day), through Saturday (2 <sup>nd</sup> Day, Sabbath), to early Sunday morning (3 <sup>rd</sup> Day).
